Recently, Jeanine and I were having our devotional study of the Gospel of John. Chapter 12 tells of Jesus' Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem. 2:2); Beginning and End (Rev. 22:13); Chief Cornerstone (Eph. 2:20); Deliverer (Rom. 11:26); Eternal Life (1 John 1:2; 5:20); Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11); Great High Priest (Heb. 4:14); Firstborn over all creation (Col. 1:15); Hope of Glory (Col. 1:27); I Am (John 8:58); King Eternal (1 Tim. 1:17); Lamb Without Blemish (1 Pet. 1:19); Mighty God (Isa. 9:6); Our Righteousness (1 Cor. 1:30); The Way, the Truth and the Life (John 14:6)

It was this Jesus, whose name is above all names, at which every knee will bow and every tongue confess, it was this Jesus who lived, died and rose again for you and me! This is actually true of every Sunday, but because of the resurrection, we have a special opportunity to embrace this humbling journey of worship. As we approach the Easter season, I pray that each of us would encounter anew the risen Lord Jesus. The resurrection calls us to a new commitment to living by faith, recognizing

Birdies for Charity

If you have a desire to help individuals and couples find freedom in Christ, please prayerfully consider using the enclosed form to donate to Freedom Ministries of the Quad Cities. The John Deere Classic Charitable Corporation sponsors Birdies For Charity in association with the John Deere classic golf tournament, July 10—16, 2017. The goal of the program is to obtain pledges (donations) of 1 cent or more for every birdie made during the tournament by the Tour Pros.

A birdie is a score of one stroke better than par for any golf hole. Par is the normal or expected score of a golf professional on any hole. If approximately 2,000 birdies are made, the total pledge would be 1 cent = \$20, 2 cents = \$40, 3 cents = \$60. Each person who makes a pledge will have the opportunity to win some great prizes. Last year birdies totaled 1,982.
