As Jeanine and I look back over the years we have walked with the Lord and served in this ministry, Nehemiah's pronouncement rings so true in our experience. We can say with him that God's grace has been there for us wherever he has called us. On August 18, Jeanine and I celebrated our 44th wedding anniversary. How amazing to think we are in our mid-60's and the Lord is still showering his grace on us, and if possible, more now than any time in our past. How often do any of us really take the time to reflect on all God has done for us?

God was so gracious to reach down into our sinful lives and rescue us, Like Titus 3:5 says, "not on the basis of deeds we have done in righteousness, but according to his mercy..."

His gracious hand was certainly upon me when He brought my precious wife into my life, my faithful companion, lover and help-mate. Her Godly character and giftedness has so helped me to be organized and on tract. She is on my team, my cheerleader and true friend.

Our God of grace led me to Moody Bible Institute in 1974 with little confidence in my learning abilities, but helped me graduate with a growing faith in God that He would enable me to accomplish more than I could think or imagine.

While a student at Moody, our first daughter, Hannah, was born two months early at 4 pounds. After a month stay in the special care nursery, no insurance, the \$10,000 bill was totally covered! The gracious hand of our God was upon us!

After graduation, we wanted to move back to our hometown in Moline. Rental housing was almost non-existent at that time. On a cold winters day, we, along with 200 other potential renters looked at a little house for rent in Molette and had only a few hour window by the owner to fill out an application. We went back to Chicago discouraged without hope of a place to live. Soon we received a letter from the owners that they wanted "us" to live there because of our Christian background and Moody! The gracious hand of our God was upon us!



God provided jobs with old friends, preserved my daughter's life from a motorcycle accident, gave us a significant church planting ministry in the Philippines and protected us from monsoons, earthquakes, coup attempts and volcanic eruptions. God showered his grace by providing caring, understanding, praying friends when our daughters were wayward, and He provided the prayer and financial support as Freedom Ministries began in 1995.

After several years as the traveling counselors, carrying all our ministry materials with us to different churches in the Quad Cities, who allowed
